**CO. CARLOW****MOUNT WOLSELEY,  
TULLOW**

Set in opulent surroundings Mount Wolseley boasts an 18-hole championship golf course. According to Christy O'Connor Junior the course designer "Rarely after a first look around a potential site for a golf course had I been so impressed as at Mount Wolseley. What we have here is a fair but testing 18 holes of Championship Golf, none of which will disappoint even the most discerning player". This par 72 course will provide a challenge to every ability as each hole presents demanding approach shots, with wide landing areas being the only concession. With its broad fairways, unforgiving rough and picturesque water hazards, Mount Wolseley has justifiably played host to a number of national and international golf competitions. Its golf course is one of the top twenty-five courses in Ireland as voted by 'Golfing Ireland'.

**CARLOW GOLF CLUB,

Set in the beautiful green countryside of the South East, Carlow Golf Club is a 27-hole parkland course laid out in a former wild deer park. With a links-like sandy sub-soil the original course is playable year round and is considered to be one of the finest inland golf courses in Ireland. The new 9-hole Oak Park Golf Course is a truly terrific layout designed by the renowned architect Jeff Howes.
